DPV[®]/DSF^{2®} Files to Support Hurricane Sandy

Primary Audience: DPV/DSF² Licensees

What: To support addresses impacted by Hurricane Sandy, the USPS[®] is providing vacant and no-stat information via a weekly download from the Electronic Product Fulfillment (EPF) website.

For the HASH products, the weekly information contains the vacant and nostat tables only; therefore, the DPV and DSF² hardcopy media (DVD) will have to be loaded as normal. The weekly vacant and no-stat tables should be appended when downloaded, allowing licensees to receive the most current information available on these two tables. The information provided in these tables contains national information and is not limited to the Hurricane impacted areas.

For the FLAT products, the weekly information contains transactional updates to the product; therefore, the DPV and DSF² hardcopy media (DVD) will have to be loaded as normal. The transactions would be applied or used in addition to the DVD product. The information provided in the file also contains national information and is not limited to the Hurricane impacted areas. It is also not limited to updates to the vacant and no-stat flags.

Use of this information is optional.

If you were previously or are currently set up through EPF, you will need to use your same login id and password. If you need access to the EPF website, please complete the attached EPF Web Access Request Form. Under Licensing/Certification Products, mark '**Other**' and enter '**Vacant/No-Stat files**' and fax it to 650-577-5773.
