LICENSING ANNOUNCEMENT MAY 7, 2012

PAF Requirements Reminder

Primary Audience: NCOA Link® Full Service, Limited Service and MPE Licensees and

FASTforward® Licensees

What: As a reminder, NCOA^{Link} and *FASTforward* licensees are required by their license agreements to acquire a Processing Acknowledgement Form (PAF) **for each of**

their customers. The PAF information includes all current data regarding the list

owner, the licensee, and any brokers, agents or list administrators.

The PAF is an essential part of the NCOA^{Link} and *FASTforward* processes because it enables the USPS[®] and the mailing industry to comply with the Privacy Act of 1974 by way of a written request to use change-of-address (COA) information for mailing purposes. The PAF:

- Identifies those mailers to whom USPS has disclosed COA information via the use of NCOA^{Link} and FASTforward processing.
- Ensures mailers' acknowledgement that use of the COA data is restricted.
- May protect the licensee if a mailer uses the processing results for reasons that abuse the intended use of the product, such as creating a list of new movers.

NCOA^{Link} and *FASTforward* licensees must acquire this form from each customer before they can provide processing. This form must be completed and signed by the list owner, the licensee and, when applicable, any third parties that are a part of the transaction between the list owner and the licensee.
