1.0 Introduction

On Wednesday, February 8, 2023, the United States Postal Service implemented the following software change:

- USPS Ship Release 7.0.1.0

These Release Notes provide the contents of the release and affected subsystems.

The section titled **Corrections to Known Issues** is derived from External Trouble Reports (ETRs) and Engineering Change Requests (ECRs) for inclusion in this release.

This document is prepared based on the knowledge available at the time of its publication and any element may be subject to change prior to publication.

2.0 USPS Ship – Enhancements, Updates, and New Functionality

2.1 Scan Service

- The release set up the Scan Service to mark duplicates as untrusted on the attribute scan and price the package using the average price. [ETR-B-699764](#)
- The release enabled the Scan Service to exclude scans if the Legacy barcode is not equal to the Package Identification Code (PIC). [REQ 5403](#)

2.2 Manifest Service

- The release updated the manifest to accept a new date format that includes time. The new date/time format is used in queries to find manifest information. The new date/time format is YYYY-MM-DDTHH:MM:SSZ [ETR B- 703571](#)
- The field label tag in the unused label rejection message changed from “manifestSubmissionDate” to “submissionDate.” [ETR B-703530](#)
- A change was made to reject packages if the Destination ZIP Code contains fewer than five digits. [ETR B-704177](#)
- The release enables the Manifest Service to update the date in the unused label rejection response. [REQ 5401](#)

2.3 Mailer Review

The release enables Mailer Review users to update the validations that occur during Unused Label Refund submissions to account for additional barcode constructs.

- Files are limited to no more than 500,000 barcodes at a time.
- Barcodes in the file must be numeric only.
- The length for each line in the submission must be 22, 26, 30, or 34 digits.
- If any barcode in the file fails validation, the entire submission will fail to process, and an error message will be sent to the user.
- If all barcodes pass validation, the submission will process with the 22- and/or 26-digit PICs, and a success message will be sent to the user. [REQ 5423](#)

3.0 USPS Ship – Corrections to Known Issues

3.1 Reporting

- The release improved performance when running the Transaction Details report. This will eliminate the error some users encounter and improve the report pagination. [ETR 1977](#)
- The release corrected an issue on the Unused Labels report so that the refund request ID is saved into the database. [ETR 1984](#)
- The release corrected differences in the summary of data and variance on the Monthly Activity Report versus the Census Verification Report. [ETR 1954](#)

3.2 Verify Service

The release differentiates between ClickNShip Outbound, ClickNShip2 Outbound, and ClickNShip2 Returns when sending to the Electronic Shortpaid Assessment System (eSAS). [ETR 2003](#)

3.3 Pricing Service

The release corrected an issue where Priority Mail or Package Services Cubic or Cubic Soft Tier packages with any one dimension greater than 18 inches is being incorrectly priced as cubic instead of single piece per the Domestic Mail Manual rules. [CR B-599875](#)

3.4 Scan Service

The release differentiates between ClickNShip and ClickNShip2 in the PC Vendor Postage Returns Flag. [ETR 2002](#)
