#### Elimination of Corporate Accounts – Updated Information

The United States Postal Service is discontinuing the United States Postal Service Corporate Accounts (USPSCA) method of payment. USPSCA includes Express Mail Corporate Accounts (EMCA) and Priority Mail Express Manifest Accounts (PMEM). In January 2023 we will begin closing inactive accounts and will be closing all USPSCA accounts by July 1, 2023.

External Customers who currently use USPSCA as a payment method are encouraged to switch to an available alternative. Alternative methods of payment may include Click-N-Ship (CNS), Electronic Verification System (eVS), ePostage, PC Postage or Meter.

Customers should contact their Sales Account/BSN Representative, if assigned one, or their local Post Office, for assistance with USPS Product/Service account migration.

Any accounts with a balance can request a refund through the resources listed below:

- Customers should contact the Mailing & Shipping Solutions Center (MSSC) @ MSSC@usps.gov for assistance.
- Please include a request for refund with a signed authorization on letterhead, EMCA #, business name and location.

Accounts with a negative balance after July 1, 2022 will be sent to Accounts Receivable for collection. Customers can make payments to negative accounts by contacting the MSSC using link above.

# USPSCA/EMCA Elimination

The Postal Service is discontinuing United States Postal Service Corporate Accounts (USPSCA), a corporate account payment method used for Express Mail Corporate Accounts (EMCA) and Priority Mail Express Manifest Accounts.

USPSCA Elimination includes all Trust, ACH Debit and Credit Card accounts

USPSCA Elimination will occur in 3 phases

Elimination of the USPSCA will result in the removal of Priority Mail Express Manifesting (Pub 97/97-A). PMEM requires USPSCA which will not longer be available.

Customers will need to move to an alternate payment option for Priority Mail Express (PME)

#### 3 Phases of Elimination

- **Phase 1** deployed on December 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022
  - Closed 5204 USPSCA with no transactions in 12 months or longer
- Phase 2 deployed on March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023
  - Closed 1342 USPSCA with no transactions in 6 months or longer
- **Phase 3** will be deployed on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023
  - Close 3842 remaining USPSCA

#### Discontinuance of Hardcopy Postage Statements

A Federal Register Notice (FRN) with the final ruling on the discontinuance of hardcopy postage statements was published April 25, 2023, effective January 28, 2024. Federal Register :: Hardcopy Postage Statements Discontinued

The Postal Service is discontinuing the use of hardcopy postage statements to improve efficiency by expediting the acceptance of commercial mail. Except for Electronic Verification System (eVS®) mailings, all domestic commercial mailings must use an approved electronic method to transmit a postage statement to the PostalOne/® system.

- Electronic documentation decreases the quantity of undocumented errors, which creates a burden on both customers and BMEUs.
- IMsb and Postal Wizard are free and easy options.
- Mailers should be aware that there are also approved third-party software options available on PostalPro at postalpro usps.com

We will continue to educate our customers on the options available to them through industry webinars on using the Intelligent Mail for Small Business (IMsb) Tool and Postal Wizard. For webinar information:

Electronic Documentation (eDoc) | PostalPro (usps.com)

- IMsb and Postal Wizard are both free to use and web-based, meaning no download or software is required.
- . IMsb and Postal Wizard guides mailers through the items they need to complete and submit a postage statement based on information they provide along the way.
- The IMsb Tool will automatically presort mailings according to the address list, providing full presort discounts such as 5-digit/AADC automation pricing. SCF entry discount will be available if eligible.
- IMsb creates Full-Service automation rate presorted mailings with unique Intelligent Mail barcodes on mail pieces and tray labels. Piece labels and tray labels are identified by tray number, simplifying mail preparation.
- IMsb cleanses the address list ensuring all addresses are valid and can identify duplicate addresses.
- Third-party software vendors also offer all the above solutions

#### What is eDoc?



eDoc is an electronic postage statement that may also contain specific information about a mailing, such as barcode information and qualification reports.

A mailing submitted electronically will appear on your dashboard.

- eDoc allows mailers to electronically submit mailing information to the *PostalOne!*® application that were traditionally provided by hardcopy postage statements and qualification reports.
- eDoc can be for automation or nonautomation pricing.

### What Can Mailers Do With eDoc?



- Complete and Submit Postage Statements
  - Submit Postage Statement Information and Supporting Documentation (Qualification Reports, etc.) electronically
- Identify Different Parties Involved in the Mailing
  - Identify party submitting the eDoc
  - Identify Mail Owner and Mail Preparer (By/For)
- Identify Barcodes
  - Barcode information for mailpieces, trays/sacks, and containers included in eDoc
- Per Piece Discounts and Ability to Waive Annual Fee due to being Full-Service/Seamless

eDoc enables faster acceptance and more accurate pricing of postage statements.



#### **Full-Service**



All mailers are encouraged to transition to electronic statements as quickly as possible to ensure they are complying by the January 2024 hardcopy elimination date, but eDoc is a requirement for Full-Service Intelligent Mail® and Seamless Acceptance

#### **KEY REQUIREMENTS**

- Apply unique Intelligent Mail barcode (IMb) to each postcard, letter, and flat
- Apply unique Intelligent Mail tray barcode (IMtb) to trays and sacks
- Apply unique Intelligent Mail container barcode (IMcb) to placards for containers (i.e. pallets) when required
  - Small volume mailings entered at a BMEU typically do not need an IMcb.
- Submit postage statements and mailing documentation electronically

#### Barcode Uniqueness

For mailings less than 10,000 pieces, mailers have two options:

Option A: Provide an Identical Barcode Serial Number within a single mailing that must maintain uniqueness across mailings for 45 days

Option B: Provide a range of unique Barcode Serial Numbers throughout a single mailing that must maintain uniqueness across mailings for 45 days.








# **Electronic Documentation of Mailing Information (eDoc)**



#### WHAT IS ELECTRONIC DOCUMENTATION (eDOC)?

eDoc is an electronic postage statement that may also contain specific information about a mailing like barcode information and qualification reports. Any mailer can submit their postage statements electronically, but eDoc is a requirement for Full-Service Intelligent Mail® or Seamless mail. eDoc allows mailers to submit mailing information that is traditionally provided via postage statements and qualification reports electronically through the PostalOne! System. eDoc enables faster and more accurate verification, acceptance, and finalization of postage statements.

#### WHAT CAN MAILERS DO WITH eDOC?

#### WHAT'S INCLUDED IN AN eDOC SUBMISSION

#### **IMsb TOOL & POSTAL WIZARD**

#### When would a mailer use the IMsb Tool?

The IMsb Tool is designed specifically for small-volume mailers that mail less than 10,000 pieces per mailing and less than 250,000 pieces annually, submitted at a BMEU, who want to prepare their own Full-Service mailings. This is a **free service** to mailers found in the BCG.

#### When would a mailer use Postal Wizard?

A mailer would use Postal Wizard for Full-Service mailings of fewer than 10,000 identical-weight pieces or less than 10,000 pieces with correct postage affixed to each mailpiece. Postal Wizard is also ideal for mailers that do infrequent, small-volume non-Full-Service mailings. This product is free until 10,000, which would then require software to provide a qualification report.

#### MAIL.DAT & MAIL.XML

#### When would a mailer use Mail.dat?

Mail.dat is designed for mailers using their own software to create electronic files containing the postage statement and qualification report. This service uses a fixed file format to send the necessary mailing information.

#### When would a mailer use Mail.XML?

Mail.XML is designed for mailers using their own software to create electronic files containing the postage statement and qualification report. This service, unlike Mail.dat, allows for two-way communication for the customer to select data fields to be submitted.
