Internet Explorer v6.0+ is the supported browser for viewing the FAST online application. The following steps will allow you to define the preferred resolution and internet browser settings.

1 Step 1: Changing the Desktop Resolution

- 1. Click the "Start" button.
- 2. Click the "Control Panel" option.
- **3.** Click the "Display" option.
- **4.** Select the "Settings" tab.
- 5. Update the screen resolution depending on your preference by scrolling the scroll bar. Select 800 by 600 pixels or 1024 by 768 pixels. The 1024 by 768 pixels setting will reduce the amount of scrolling required.
- 6. Click the "Apply" button.
- 7. The following message will display, "Your desktop settings have been reconfigured. Do you want to keep these settings?"
- 8. Click the "Yes" button.
- 9. Click the "OK" button.

- **2.** Select the text size.
 - a. Click the "View" menu.

 - c. Click the "Medium" option.
- 3. Select encoding.

- **4.** Select the text presentation.

 - d. Adjust the settings to "Medium."

 - b. Click the "Internet Options..." option.
 - c. Select the "Advanced" tab.
