Republication of Mail Direction File Due to Technical Error

An error has been identified in the Mail Direction File (MDF) that was published on June 1, 2021 with an effective date of July 1, 2021. Due to a technical error, both the Auxiliary Service Facility (ASF) and Network Distribution Center (NDC) are identified in the MDF as default entry facilities for the DNDC discount. However, for the 111 ZIPs serviced by an ASF, the mail should be routed and entered at the ASF, not the NDC. This is a technical error and there are no intended changes being made to the routing of mail and no ASFs have been eliminated. IT is working to resolve the issue and the MDF will be republished with corrected data by Friday, June 18, 2021.

We appreciate your assistance in continuing to route mail to the designated ASF and apologize for any inconvenience this technical error may cause.
