Today(Sunday, **January 23**, 2022),from **4:15 AM CT through 9:00 AM CT**, the United States Postal Service implemented software updates for the following systems:

- > SASP Release 29.1.0.0
- > BIDS 53.1.0.0

The Seamless Acceptance and Service Performance(SASP) Release 29.1.0.0 and BIDS 53.1.0.0 Release Notes (*Change* 1.0) document is attached and also posted to PostalPro @ https://postalpro.usps.com/January-23-2022-release-notes.

After the release (*January* 23, 2022) Mail Owner MIDs with a singular relationship with an eDoc Submitter CRID will now be able to generate a new Undocumented category 14 errors visible on the Mailer Scorecard and MQD feeds.

Category 14 errors will be marked as warnings during the grace period.

Mailers who subscribe to MQD should ensure they are receiving warnings as part of their Undocumented feed if they would like visibility into the category 14 errors
