Current Manual Error Removal Process

- Only performed for Seamless CRIDs that exceeded the assessment threshold for undocumented pieces
- Undocumented errors removed when barcodes could be matched to eDoc older than 45 days from the scan date
- DR run once prior to Scorecard being locked and assessments generated for previous month activity
- Impacted mailers were notified via generic e-mail from HQ Mail Entry mailbox



Delayed Scan Undocumented Error Removal - Enhanced

Enhanced Automated Error Removal Process – 1/23/2022

- Performed for all Seamless CRIDs regardless of threshold status
- Undocumented errors removed when barcodes could be matched to eDoc older than 45 days from the scan date
- Error removal process is performed daily and will update Scorecard the following day
- Mailers using IV-MQD should identified error removal by leveraging the "Error Deactivation" indicator in their MQD Undocumented feeds



Mail In Measurement Relationship to Mailer Scorecard







Length is the longest dimensionWidth is the second-longest dimensionHeight is the shortest dimension


Non-Standard fee applies to:

Non-Compliance fee applies to:

Packages with no manifest data provided and captured length > 22" or volume (LxWxH) > 1,728 in³ Packages with inaccurate manifest data and captured length > 22" or volume (LxWxH) > 1,728 in³


Mailers must provide dimensions when the package's cubic volume measures over one cubic foot (1,728 inches)

Zone 10

 The USPS is considering a modification to the zone list by including Zone 10 as a new supported zone. Zone 10 would be limited to competitive products, which include: Priority Mail Express, Priority Mail, USPS Retail Ground, First-Class Package Service, Parcel Return Service (full network), and Parcel Select Ground.

Zone Modernization

 The USPS is considering a modification to current zone calculation for competitive products. The current method uses one Zone Chart Matrix to calculate zones for competitive and market dominant products by using a 3-Digit origin SCF to 3-Digit destinating SCF ZIP Code mapping to calculate zones. The proposed structure will consist of two sets of zone data: one for market dominant products and the other for competitive products. The zone structure for market dominant will continue to use a 3-Digit ZIP Code origin to 3-Digit ZIP Code destination mapping. For competitive products, the zone mapping would be based on 3-Digit ZIP Code origin to 5-Digit ZIP Code destination.

- Chain of custody and start-the-clock
- Integration with new features, technology, innovations

Verbal Redirect versus MDF in FAST

Two verbal redirects during Peak Season addressed by Processing & Delivery

- DDU Northville, MI 48167 to Farmington Hills MI DDU
- Lehigh Valley PA SCF, 26 pallets of 5-digit SCF discount mail to Northampton PA DDU

All Emergency Redirects should be entered in the Mail Direction Errata File.





- Issue: PostalOne! postage statements paid for via EPS account encountered "Stuck in Payment" issues, where elnduction containers were not timely marked as paid; resulting in rejection at Mail Entry/Acceptance.
- **Root Cause**: Two areas were identified and improved upon to resolve this issue 1) Hardware capacity to handle burst transactions and 2) Database performance.
- Resolution & Monitoring: Recent PMT issues were resolved by increasing Hardware capacity and improving database performance. Enhanced level of monitoring has been implemented to ensure action as needed.
- Future/On-Going: Continue to monitor and in the event the issue reoccurs, we will
 communicate to the mailers in a timely manner via Industry Alerts.
