Changes to DMM®, Section 602, Addressing

Effective October 1, 2022, the Postal Service will update the addressing standards in Section 602 of the Domestic Mail Manual (DMM)®. For further information, please see the [Federal Register Notice](#) published on July 7, 2021 and [Postal Bulletin 22603](#) which was published on July 28, 2022.

USPS will not require software vendors to release updated software with changes to the PS Form 3553 until August 1, 2023. Mailers will be required to adhere to the changes outlined in the Federal Register Notice effective October 1, 2022.
