






I am spread through infected mosquitoes


Signs and symptoms include:


Diagnosis 3

I caused millions of deaths worldwide. 3 out of 10 people who contracted me died!




Exposing people to a related virus lead to the discovery of a vaccine. It was the first vaccine developed against a contagious disease.




The last case in the United States occurred in 1949.


