

# LICENSING ANNOUNCEMENT

## **NO-STAT REASON CODE TABLE**

Primary Audience: All DSF<sup>2</sup>® Licensees Receiving the Hash Products

The USPS® has added a new table to the DSF<sup>2</sup> Hash Product called No-Stat Reason Code Table. This table will provide details as to why the records are flagged as No-Stats. This table is **optional** and will be available beginning in the May product, which will be posted to the Electronic Product Fulfillment (EPF) website on Monday, April 23.

The No-Stat Reason Code Table will be included in the DSF<sup>2</sup> Full (**dph.hsr**) and Split (**dph.hsr.zall**) Products.

During CASS™ processing if a 'Y' is received on the DPV No-Stat table, you will need to query the No-Stat Reason Code Table for the type of No-Stat record received. Reason codes are listed below.

<b>Reason Code</b>	<b>Code Description</b>
1 – IDA (Internal Drop Address)	These are addresses that do not receive mail delivery directly from the USPS, but are delivered to a drop address that services them.
2 – CDS No-Stat	These are addresses that have not yet become deliverable. For example, a new subdivision where lots and primary numbers have been determined, but no structure exists yet for occupancy.
3 – Collision	These addresses do not actually DPV confirm. In this case, the 'Y' should be set to an 'N' on the DPV 'A' table and all other table values should be blank.
4 – CMZ (College, Military and Other Types)	These are ZIP + 4® records USPS has incorporated into the data.
5 – Regular No-Stat	Indicates addresses not receiving delivery and the addresses are not counted as possible deliveries.

Attached is the DSF<sup>2</sup> Software Developer Guide (SDG) reflecting the addition of the No-Stat Reason Code Table. The DSF<sup>2</sup> License Performance Requirements (LPR), located at [https://postalpro.usps.com/DSF2\\_LPR](https://postalpro.usps.com/DSF2_LPR), has also been updated.
