## 1.0 Introduction

On Sunday, March 11, 2018, the United States Postal Service will implement the following software change:

- *PostalOne!* System Release 47.0.2.1

This document is prepared based on the knowledge available at the time of its publication and any element may be subject to change prior to publication.

## 2.0 Mail.dat Client Support

Please note the following regarding the Mail.dat client download.

An optional updated Mail.dat client version is available with this release. The updated client resolves an issue with slow performance in large Informed Delivery campaigns containing high piece counts (ETR 12169). Users can continue to use existing Mail.dat client version 47.0.0.0\_PROD, or may optionally download the updated Mail.dat client version 47.0.2.1\_PROD. The updated client can be downloaded from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).

## 3.0 *PostalOne!* System - Corrections to Known Issues

### 3.1 Electronic Data Exchange

Mail.dat will be updated to improve performance so that large Informed Delivery campaigns containing millions of mail pieces will no longer cause excess consumption of memory within the Mail.dat Upload Server. Optional Mail.dat client version 47.0.2.1\_PROD will be provided to resolve this issue and can be downloaded by mailers who are experiencing slow performance in processing large Informed Delivery campaigns.
