## 1.0 Introduction

## 2.0 Mail.dat Client Support

Please note the following regarding the Mail.dat client download.

There is no new Mail.dat client version with this release. Users should continue to use Mail.dat client version 47.1.0.0\_PROD or version 47.1.1.0\_PROD. The current Mail.dat Client may be downloaded from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).

## 3.0 *PostalOne!* System - Corrections to Known Issues

### 3.1 Electronic Data Exchange

Mail.dat processing was updated to properly account for the portion of a mixed-class bundle that is USPS Marketing Mail when calculating bundle charges. Previously, the bundle charge did not exclude the USPS Marketing Mail portion when the bundle charge was apportioned across the Periodicals statements. This caused the bundle charge to be greater than it should have been. [12341 \(19490-R\)](#)

### 3.2 Postage Statement Processing

The Mail Entry Invoice Assessment creation process was updated to properly account for adjustment data. Previously, the process did not receive the updated data due to an issue with the completion date being null (blank). As a result, mailers did not see confirmation that a payment had been made using their Enterprise Payment System (EPS) account, and could incorrectly click the payment option more than once.
