## 2.0 Mail.dat Client Support

Please note the following regarding the Mail.dat client download.

There is **no** new Mail.dat client version with this release. Users should continue to use Mail.dat client version 47.3.0.0\_PROD. The current Mail.dat Client may be downloaded from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).

**<u>NOTE</u>**: The next new required Mail.dat client version is scheduled for *PostalOne!* Release 47.4.1.0 on Sunday, October 21, 2018.

# 3.0 PostalOne! System - Corrections to Known Issues

## 3.1 Account Management

Account balances for Centralized Account Processing System (CAPS) permits that are migrating to the Enterprise Payment System (EPS) will be transferred to the EPS account at the time of permit migration. Following *PostalOne!* System Release 47.4.0.0 on September 23, 2018, balances for CAPS accounts failed to migrate to the associated EPS account when the permit was transferred. In addition to correcting the migration of CAPS balances to their associated EPS accounts in real time, the account balances for permits already impacted by the issue will be migrated from CAPS to EPS. 12666 (19966-R)
