

## **LICENSING ANNOUNCEMENTS**

### **JULY 13, 2007**

As a reminder, the CASS™ 2006-2007 (Cycle K) version of the AMS API Product will cease to function effective August 1, 2007. You must upgrade to the CASS 2007-2008 (Cycle L) version before this deadline.

Additionally, with the inclusion of the DPV and LACS<sup>Link</sup> Products in the AMS API Product, a False Positive table is included in the product to detect conditions where address records appear to be artificially manufactured (refer to section 2.0 of Exhibits E and G in the AMS API License Agreement). In cases of such occurrences, a Stop Processing function will halt processing and the End User's name and address must be reported to the USPS® via [dsf2stop@usps.gov](mailto:dsf2stop@usps.gov) following the False Positive Reporting layout.
