## *PostalOne!* Release 48.0.2.0

On February 10, 2019 from **4:00 AM CT – 10 AM CT**, the United States Postal Service will conduct quarterly maintenance activities. In addition, the following software change will be implemented:

- *PostalOne!* System Release 48.0.2.0

**NOTE:** This is a rolling release. The *PostalOne!* System will be available. However, users may experience intermittent connectivity issues during the cited maintenance and deployment timeframe.

Users should download Mail.dat client version 48.1.0.0\_PROD from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).
