As an effort to provide a more efficient method for USPS® product fulfillment, the USPS is seeking beta testers for a new electronic product fulfillment service. This service will allow fulfillment of large products, such as NCOA<sup>Link®</sup>, DPV®, DSF<sup>2®</sup> and AMS API, currently not fulfilled through EPF. This service will be provided as a web service only; therefore a user interface will not be provided. This method will require the beta tester to develop an application to call the USPS web service to utilize this solution. If you elect to participate in this beta test, please review, sign and return the attached beta terms and conditions agreement to our office no later than March 15, 2013. Also attached is an Electronic Product Fulfillment (EPF) Web Access Request Form to complete and return.

During the beta testing period, the products included in this test will be received at the same time as the normal hardcopy DVD fulfillment. Therefore by participating in this beta test, there should be no expectation of receiving the products sooner than the normal DVD hardcopy product fulfillment. However, when the beta testing completes, data extracted using the web service may be fulfilled sooner than the DVD fulfillment.

Your participation would be greatly appreciated. Once we receive your confirmation to participate in the beta test, more detailed instructions will be provided.
