These characters are currently not supported. However, Mail.dat validation did not explicitly check for them in client versions prior to March 17, 2019, at which time the Mail.dat error code 0123 was downgraded to a warning message. With this release, Mail.dat warning 0123 will be reinstated to error code status. The description for error code 0123 is: "The .mpa MPA Description field must be populated with an alphanumeric value (when populated)". Validation logic for the eVS manifest loader will be updated to remove an outdated check that prevents the mailer from manifesting using a Service Type Code (STC) that has the Return Receipt extra service coupled with any of the combined Certified Mail Extra Service Codes (ESCs 911, 912, or 913). This validation is no longer needed since eVS now derives the Extra Service Codes from the STC, guaranteeing that they are valid. An unrelated defect resolution implemented on March 17, 2019 inadvertently re-activated this dormant validation check. As a result of the outdated validation, some mail pieces could be rejected erroneously from mailers' manifests and charged average postage. In that scenario, the following manifest error message would be generated: "Invalid special service combination Reason: Invalid Special Service: RR needs to have either CM or IM or COD."

This performance issue is due to updates made to Earned Value promotions where CRID is now used (instead of MID) for calculating CRM/BRM/ShareMail volumes. The 2018 Threshold for 2019 Earned Value Program will be used to compare the upcoming 2019 Earned Value volume of registered mailers to calculate a credit only if 98% of the 2018 Threshold for 2019 Earned Value program volume (CRM/BRM/Share Mail) is mailed by mailers in 2019. The 2019 Earned Value Promotion's registration begins March 31, 2019.
