1.0 Introduction

On Sunday, April 14, 2019, the United States Postal Service implemented the following software changes:

- PostalOne! System Release 48.1.1.0
- Program Registration 20.1.1.0

These Release Notes provide the contents of the releases and affected subsystems.

The sections titled *Corrections to Known Issues* are derived from External Trouble Reports (ETRs) and Engineering Change Requests (ECRs) for inclusion in these releases.

This document is prepared based on the knowledge available at the time of its publication and any element may be subject to change prior to publication.

2.0 Mail.dat Client Support

Please note the following regarding the Mail.dat client download.

There is **no** updated Mail.dat client version with this release. Users should continue to use Mail.dat client version **48.1.0.0_PROD.** The current Mail.dat client can be downloaded from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).

3.0 PostalOne! System - Corrections to Known Issues

3.1 Electronic Verification System (eVS®)

Validation logic for the eVS manifest loader has been updated to remove an outdated check that prevented the mailer from manifesting using a Service Type Code (STC) that had the Return Receipt extra service coupled with any of the combined Certified Mail Extra Service Codes (ESCs 911, 912, or 913). This validation is no longer needed since eVS now derives the Extra Service Codes from the STC, guaranteeing that they are valid. An unrelated defect resolution implemented on March 17, 2019 inadvertently re-activated this dormant validation check. As a result of the outdated validation, some mail pieces could be rejected erroneously from mailers' manifests and charged average postage. In that scenario, the following manifest error message will be generated: "Invalid special service combination Reason: Invalid Special Service: RR needs to have either CM or IM or COD". 13109 (20474-R)

4.0 Program Registration – Corrections to Known Issues

In support of the Informed Delivery campaign to be activated on April 14, 2019, several updates have been made to the procedures for data transfer between Program Registration and Informed Delivery. The updates enable Informed Delivery campaigns to appear in Program Registration so that users can view the campaign information in their activity reports. Program Registration supports an updated Informed Delivery campaign report file format, with the following changes:

- The Status field accepts uppercase values.
- The Campaign Start Date and Campaign End Date fields are in the date format "MM/DD/YYYY".
- The Campaign Title field accepts up to 255 characters. 2424-G
