1.0 Introduction

On Thursday June 13, 2019, the United States Postal Service will implement the following software change:

- *PostalOne!* System Release 49.0.0.1

These Pre-Release Notes provide the contents of the release and affected subsystems.

The section titled **Corrections to Known Issues** is derived from External Trouble Reports (ETRs) and Engineering Change Requests (ECRs) for inclusion in this release.

This document is prepared based on the knowledge available at the time of its publication and any element may be subject to change prior to publication.

2.0 Mail.dat Client Support

Please note the following regarding the Mail.dat client download.

There is **no** new Mail.dat client version with this release. Users should continue to use Mail.dat client version **49.0.0.0_PROD**, which can be downloaded from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).

3.0 *PostalOne!* System – Corrections to Known Issues

3.1 Account Management

The *PostalOne!* System will implement appropriate exception handling in order to prevent iCAPS customers from being able to migrate their permits from the Centralized Account Processing System (CAPS) to the Enterprise Payment System (EPS) prematurely. A logic issue in the implementation of an unrelated EPS change in *PostalOne!* System release 49.0.0.0 unintentionally allowed iCAPS migrations to EPS to proceed instead of recognizing the CAPS flag indicating that the account could not be migrated. The updated exception handling will correct this issue. [13352](#)

3.2 Postal Wizard

The Postal Wizard will be updated to correct an error that prevents users from submitting USPS Marketing Mail postage statements under certain conditions. The following error is generated when users attempt to enter a USPS Marketing Mail statement claiming Section E flats with minimum piece counts (fewer than 125 pieces): *"The following Flat line items(s) require a minimum of 125 pieces or 15 pounds (E1). Exception: Origin Sack may contain less than 124 pieces or 15 pounds"*. As a temporary workaround until the issue is resolved, users submitting statements that claim section E with a piece count of fewer than 125 pieces can request that the Business Mail Entry Unit (BMEU) manually enter the statement instead of submitting it through the Postal Wizard.
