REMINDER: Scheduled System Activities – July 28 and August 25

The United States Postal Service has system releases scheduled for the following dates:

- Sunday, July 28, 2019
- Sunday, August 25, 2019

This Sunday, **July 28**, 2019 from **4:00 AM CT – 10:00 AM CT**, software changes will be implemented for the following systems:

- *PostalOne!* System Release 49.0.2.0
- Electronic Shortpaid Assessment System (eSAS) Release 16.0.0.0
- Program Registration Release 20.2.1.0
- Seamless Acceptance and Service Performance (SASP) Release 26.1.1.1

As previously-advised, *PostalOne!* System Release 49.0.2.0 will result in a new **required** Mail.dat client version. After the July 28 release deploys, users should download Mail.dat client version **49.0.2.0_PROD** from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services è Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] è Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).

On Sunday, **August 25**, 2019, from **4:00 AM – 10:00 AM CT**, the following system releases are scheduled:

- *PostalOne!* System Release 49.1.0.0
- Enterprise Payment System (EPS) Release 3.9.0.0

REMINDER: *PostalOne!* System Release 49.1.0.0 will result in a new **required** Mail.dat client version. After the August 25 release deploys, users should download Mail.dat client version **49.1.0.0_PROD** from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services è Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] è Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).
