PostalOne! System Release 49.2.0.1 – October 22

On Tuesday, **October 22**, 2019, the United States Postal Service implemented the following software update:

• PostalOne! System Release 49.2.0.1

PostalOne! System Release 49.2.0.1 was an expedited release that updated Mail.dat and Mail.XML processing to resolve an issue which prevented eDocs from generating the applicable Informed Delivery incentive discount. This issue was a result of a reporting change implemented during *PostalOne!* System Release 49.2.0.0 last Sunday, October 20.

This reporting change inadvertently impacted the ability for eDoc campaign submissions to claim the Informed Delivery incentive. Prior to the resolution of this issue, impacted campaign submissions failed to generate the Informed Delivery incentive discount, and did not generate a warning with an explanation of the failure. Users may have received internal errors on the Mail.dat client, and/or received a report of erroneous "PI 0 0" records within the dashboard. A review of impacted statements is underway to determine warranted refunds.
