On Sunday, October 27, 2019, the United States Postal Service implemented the following software change:

#### 2.0 Mail.dat Client Support

Please note the following regarding the Mail.dat client download.

There is no new Mail.dat client with this release. Users should continue to use Mail.dat client **49.2.0.0\_PROD**, which was required with the Sunday, October 20 deployment of *PostalOne!* System Release 49.2.0.0. The current Mail.dat client may be downloaded from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).

#### 3.0 PostalOne! System - Corrections to Known Issues

#### 3.1 Electronic Data Exchange

An issue was corrected in Mail.dat that prevented the Informed Delivery incentive discount from generating for eDocs where a single Mail Piece Unit (MPU) spanned multiple postage statements. While checking to see whether an MPU had pieces that qualified for the Informed Delivery incentive discount, the system incorrectly denied the incentive discount to all postage statements pertaining to the MPU when *any* of the postage statements did not have qualifying pieces.

A review of impacted statements is in progress to determine refunds where appropriate. 13632
