

# **North Houston P&DC Update**

## ***Operational Briefing***

October 15, 2019



## September 19-25<sup>th</sup>

- September 19 all processing facilities in Houston District closed for operations.
- Embargo PME, Marketing Letters & Flats
- Redirection plan for air and surface (Packages, Letters, Flats) was implemented.
- 15 different facilities included in redirection and processing plans.
- September 22 Beaumont P&DF and Partial North Houston P&DC cleared to be occupied.
- Package and Flat Processing resumes in Houston. PME & Marketing Flats embargo lifted
- Redirection of letter mail continued.
- September 24 last of known unprocessed mail completely removed from expansion area & dispatched to DFW recovery processing site.

## **September 25<sup>th</sup> – October 15<sup>th</sup>**

- Continue to communicate with employees current processes and new updates.
- Daily mail flow reporting and corrections made.
- Monitor mail volumes to support mail processing at offload sites.
- Develop timeline to re-open expansion side of North Houston building.
- Develop project timeline to bring mail volumes back to North Houston.

- Note: **SCF 759** collection mail redirected to Shreveport PDC (711)

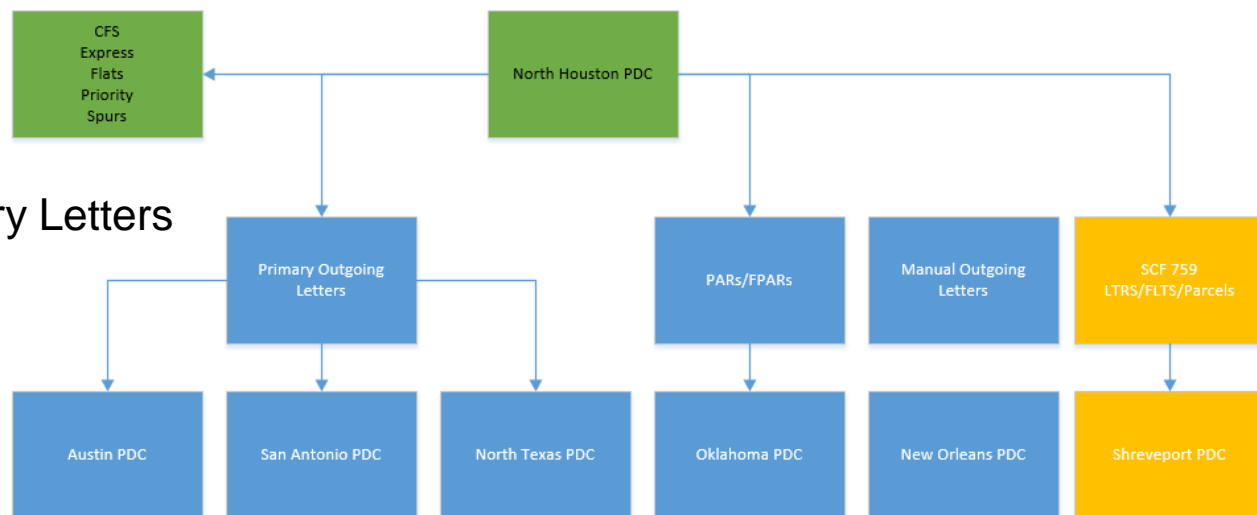

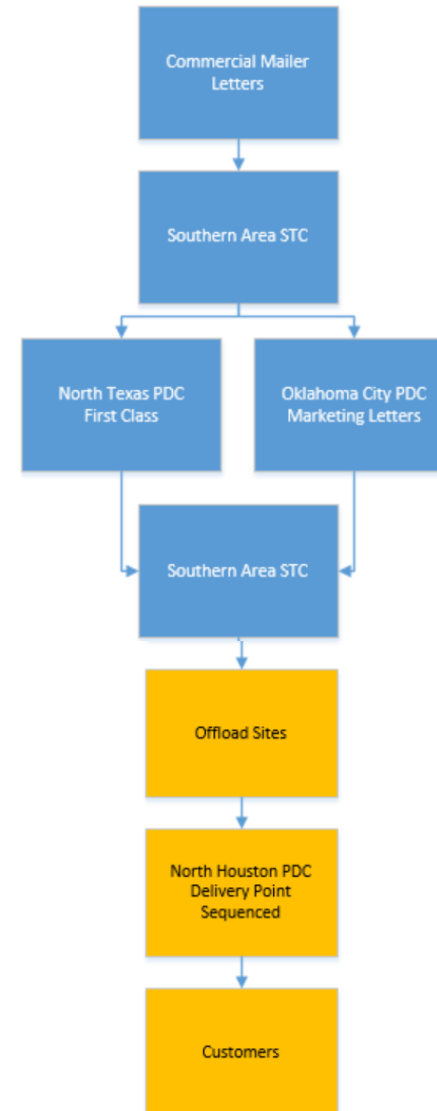

## First Class & Marketing Letters



## October 15<sup>th</sup> & Moving Forward:

- Demising wall to cordon off the collapsed area has been completed
- Shoring and bracing completed 10/14/19
- The undamaged portion of the building will be returned to operations 10/15
- Estimated completion of rebuilding the collapsed area is approximately the end of December 2019

- Redirection of letter mail continues
- Expansion recovery team currently on site
  - Lost 12 DBCS' (4 machines total loss 8 removed for rebuild)
  - Extending machines to 270 and 302
  - Updated all RPGs DPS sort plans with 56 DBCS'
  - Moving three (3) phase 6 machines to Beaumont for contingency
- Re-entry plan is metered
  - Resume full outgoing operations 10/21
  - Redirect Marketing Mail 10/22
  - Resume full DPS processing 10/23
