## 2.0 Package Platform – Corrections to Known Issues

### 2.1 Mailer Review Service

The Package Platform Mailer Review Service has been updated to correct a performance issue preventing large-volume mailers from being able to retrieve their package data via Mailer Review. Correcting this issue allows mailers to retrieve their package data properly and helps maintain accurate records. [734-P](#)

### 2.2 Pricing Service

The Package Platform Pricing Service has been updated to correct an issue where some scans with large dimensions captured by the scan service were charged using dimensional-weight pricing even though the dimensional-weight pricing trust indicator was set to false. Correcting this issue enables accurate pricing for future scans. [777-P](#)
