1.0 Introduction

On Thursday, November 21, 2019, the United States Postal Service implemented the following software change:

- Package Platform Release 1.7.6.0

These Release Notes provide the contents of the release and affected subsystems.

The section titled **Corrections to Known Issues** is derived from External Trouble Reports (ETRs) and Engineering Change Requests (ECRs) for inclusion in this release.

This document is prepared based on the knowledge available at the time of its publication and any element may be subject to change prior to publication.

2.0 Package Platform – Corrections to Known Issues

2.1 Mailer Review Service

- An update was made to rectify a price scanning issue. A defect introduced in Package Platform Release 1.7.0.0 on September 12, 2019 resulted in some price scans for packages with large dimensions being incorrectly charged using dimensional weight pricing even though their dimensional trust indicator was set to false. The logic was updated in Package Platform Release 1.7.4.0 on November 7, 2019 to alleviate this issue and enable accurate pricing for the scenario. Packages priced prior to November 7, 2019 that may have been impacted by the issue were evaluated and repriced with the updated logic in order to properly price the packages and apply adjustments as needed. - An update was made to reconcile postage for packages that were incorrectly priced using attributes instead of average prices. The logic issue was resolved in Package Platform Release 1.7.1.0 on September 25, 2019 to enable accurate pricing for this scenario. Packages that were previously affected by this issue before Release 1.7.1.0 were evaluated and repriced with the updated logic to apply adjustments as necessary. [825-P \(2678-PR\)](#)

2.2 Data Service

An update was made to the Package Platform database to enable data from November 19, 2019 to be sent to mailers by the Data Transfer service based on the mailers' subscription preferences. Previously, the data failed to be sent because of an unexpected issue that occurred on November 19, 2019. [834-P \(2679-PR\)](#)
