On Monday, November 25, 2019, the United States Postal Service implemented the following software change:

2.0 Package Platform – Corrections to Known Issues

2.1 Scan Service

Scan Service performed a data update to resolve an issue caused by a system event that occurred on Friday, November 22, 2019. Processing was reset to a time period prior to the system event; and all processing was paused until the issue is resolved.

This issue impacted USPS Automated Returns customers and Electronic Shortpaid Assessment System (eSAS) evaluation and invoicing for shortpaid packages. Informed Visibility Mail Tracking and Reporting (IV-MTR) and Enterprise Payment System (EPS) reporting are impacted by this delay as well. Upon resolution of the issue, processing and reporting will resume. [848-PI](#)
