## January 26, 2020 System Releases

On Sunday, **January 26, 2020** from **3:00 AM CT to 12:00 PM CT**, the United States Postal Service will implement the following software changes:

- *PostalOne!* System Release 50.0.1.0
- Centralized Account Processing System (CAPS) Release 50.0.1.0

During the cited timeframes, these systems will not be available.

**NOTE:** Please note the following regarding the Mail.dat client download.

- There is no new Mail.dat client with this release. Users should continue to use Mail.dat client **50.0.0.0\_PROD**, which was required with *PostalOne!* System Release 50.0.0.0 on January 12, 2020. Mail.dat client **50.0.0.0\_PROD** can be downloaded from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services è Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] è Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).
- **Beginning with *PostalOne!* Release 50.0.0.0 (January 12, 2020) and continuing thereafter**, the Mail.dat client Windows 32-bit and 64-bit downloads come bundled with AdoptOpenJDK version 8. Users utilizing the Solaris version of the Mail.dat client must continue to ensure they have downloaded and installed OpenJDK 8u232 ([AdoptOpenJDK – Download](#)).
