## 1.0 Introduction

On Sunday, February 23, 2020, the United States Postal Service implemented the following software changes:

- Enterprise Payment System (EPS) Release 3.11.0.2
- Universal Pricing Engine (UPE) Release 7.0.1.0

These Release Notes provide the contents of the releases and affected subsystems.

The sections titled **Corrections to Known Issues** are derived from External Trouble Reports (ETRs) and Engineering Change Requests (ECRs) for inclusion in these releases.

This document is prepared based on the knowledge available at the time of its publication and any element may be subject to change prior to publication.

## 2.0 Enterprise Payment System (EPS) - Corrections to Known Issues

### 2.1 Commercial Mail Transactions

The Enterprise Payment System (EPS) processing was updated to revise the logic for the Customer Registration ID (CRID) provided in customer EPS transaction data subscriptions through Informed Visibility Mail Tracking and Reporting (IV-MTR). Since the IV-MTR EPS data feeds had been providing the permit CRID instead of the account CRID since the January 12, 2020 release, some subscribed customers had not been receiving their full IV-MTR files since that date.

This issue impacted customers who manage EPS through accounts associated to just one CRID or a small subset of CRIDs that do not align to their full set of permit CRIDs.

Customers who use the same CRID on their permit(s) and EPS Account(s) were not impacted. [1626-EI](#)

## 3.0 Universal Pricing Engine (UPE) – Corrections to Known Issues

### 3.1 Commercial Base Pricing

The Universal Pricing Engine (UPE) was updated to ensure that the pricing logic for Commercial Base Regional Rate Box A and Regional Rate Box B pricing category consistently returns Commercial Base pricing for packages meeting the eligibility for Regional Rate Box A or B. [650-U](#)
