UPDATE: Package Platform Release 2.3.0.0 – **Thursday, September 10, 2020**

As previously advised, yesterday (**Thursday, September 10, 2020**), the United States Postal Service implemented the following software update:

Customers were notified that, during the implementation and validation window, there was an impact to Package Platform, Enterprise Payment System (EPS) and Informed Visibility-Mail Tracking and Reporting (IV-MTR) resulting in delayed receipt of the following datasets:
