PRC Approves 2021 Price Change for Competitive International Products

The Postal Regulatory Commission (PRC) approved the United States Postal Service price change for Competitive International products to take effect on January 24, 2021.

In the order, the PRC stated that it "approves the proposed price changes and updates the Mail Classification Schedule (MCS) to reflect the new prices." An overview of the approved average percent price increase by product or category is summarized in the table below.
