Reminder: Package Platform Release 2.3.3.0 – *Thursday, November 5, 2020*

Tomorrow (*Thursday, November 5, 2020*), from 8:00 AM CT – 12:00 PM CT, the United States Postal Service will implement the following software update:

Package Platform Release 2.3.3.0

Note that during the cited implementation and validation window, there will be an impact to Package Platform, Enterprise Payment System (EPS) and Informed Visibility-Mail Tracking and Reporting (IV-MTR) resulting in delayed receipt of the following datasets:

- Pricing Notification for USPS Returns service
- > Final Notification for **USPS Returns** service
- All Enterprise Payment System (EPS) Data Feeds
 - Bank Account Withdrawals
 - Postage Statement Details
 - iCAPS Invoices
 - Transactions
 - Commercial Mailings
 - Network Returns
 - PO Boxes
 - Deposits & Trust Corrections
 - Address Quality
 - Domestic Outbound

Based on an assessment of forecasted volume, it is anticipated data will be current by the end of the day tomorrow (*Thursday, November 5, 2020*). However, during post-release activities, we will continue to monitor progress and provide updated status assessments.
