*PostalOne! System Release 52.0.0.0 includes a new REQUIRED Mail.dat client. After implementation concludes, users should download Mail.dat client 52.0.0.0_PROD from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services è Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] è Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).
