Seamless Acceptance/Full-Service Automated Verification Reminder

The Postal Service is leveraging Full-Service Intelligent Mail to transition towards automated acceptance and verification processes that will replace the traditional manual verifications. As part of this process, the Postal Service provided advance notice in the May 8th 2020 Seamless Federal Register of its intent to require all mailers with an authorized Detached Mail Unit (DMU) to enroll in the Seamless Acceptance Program by May 1, 2021. DMU Mailers not enrolled in the Seamless Acceptance Program by that date may be required to submit commercial mailings at a designated Business Mail Entry Unit (BMEU). BMEU-entered full-service mailings will be verified using only automated sampling and verification processes beginning July 1, 2021.

In the current verification environment, mail is verified manually by an acceptance employee before entry and finalization. The employee performs a cursory review, collects Full-Service initial verification mail samples, conducts in-depth Performance Based Verifications (PBV) as requested by *PostalOne!*, and finalizes the postage statement.

Full-Service and Seamless Acceptance automates the verification process, streamlining entry verifications. The Seamless Acceptance and Full-Service Automated Verification and Sampling error verification thresholds are listed below:

Metric	Threshold	Root Cause of Error
Undocumented Pieces	0.3%	An Undocumented Error is logged when a scanned Intelligent Mail barcode cannot be found in eDoc that has an associated finalized postage statement within the last 45 days
Nesting/Sortation Piece (MPE)	1.0%	Trays/Bundles not nested or sorted in the manner stated in eDoc
Delivery Point Piece	2.0%	A Delivery Point Error is logged when the 5-, 9-, or 11-digit routing code portion of the Intelligent Mail barcode is invalid, the wrong length, or missing in the eDoc
General Sampling Postage Adjustment Factor (PAF)	1.05	Weight information from sampled mailpieces does not match what is listed in eDoc and crosses a weight category or error threshold for pound postage. If the postage affixed amount, or the postage payment method, of the sampled piece does not match the postage information in the eDoc.
Mail Characteristic PAF	1.05	Mailpiece characteristics from sampled mailpieces do not match what is listed in eDoc (processing category, class of mail, Marketing Mail/Nonprofit eligibility)

Note: At this time, the USPS will not Auto-Finalize or assess the Undocumented Metric for Full-Service Mailers. However, Full-Service mailers should continue to establish quality processes in order to reduce their undocumented. The Full-Service Automated Verification errors will report to the Seamless tab of the scorecard. Also, mailers must be enrolled in full Seamless to be eligible for the Seamless Incentive.

Improve Your Quality Processes

- Review data from research with internal teams

- Pinpoint gap areas that need improvement
- Implement improvement plan and document

Be Proactive

- Monitor Mail Scorecard results DAILY
- Research issues even if they are below threshold
- Document and improve processes identified during research
