National Center for Employee Development Update on Certification Programs

The National Center for Employee Development (NCED) offers two certification programs for PCCs to host locally or virtually.

The Executive Mail Center Manager (EMCM) course is a comprehensive training program designed for individuals who wish to develop Mail Center Management skills. It offers a professional designation that emphasizes professionalism in Mail Center Management. The course teaches skills needed to manage more effectively, boost productivity and cut costs. The program is sponsored by the U.S. Postal Service and developed by a professional committee with representatives from the mailing industry. Participants are required to complete eight modules to earn certification.

The Mail Design Professional (MDP) course provides in depth training on postal standards related to designing letter and flat mail, to facilitate processing on high-speed automated equipment, while maximizing cost effectiveness, and reducing processing delays.
