Effective immediately, Garrett Hoyt will serve as Acting Vice President, Technology Applications.

Most recently, Garrett held the position of Executive Director of CIO Services where he oversaw the strategic planning, financial management and software acquisition team that successfully negotiated the Enterprise Technology Services, TIPN and other strategic contracts resulting in significant savings to the organization. As Acting Manager, Rural Delivery he successfully managed the development, training, and deployment of a nationwide route mapping pilot that included ~1k complex routes originating from ~70 districts in a two-month time frame. He is a graduate of the Executive Leadership Program and Senior Executive Assessment Program.

Garrett replaces Marc McCrery who has accepted a position as Vice President, Customer Experience, in the Chief Customer and Marketing Officer and Executive Vice President's organization.
