[UPDATE: ROLLBACK OF TIME-LIMITED PRICE CHANGE 2021]

Scheduled Commercial System Releases – *Sunday, December 12, 2021*

As previously advised, the United States Postal Service will implement software updates in preparation for **rollback of Time-Limited Price Change 2021** [effective Sunday, **October 3, 2021** through Saturday, **December 25, 2021**.] This Sunday, **December 12, 2021**, from **5:00 AM CT – 12:00 PM CT**, the following Commercial Systems are scheduled:

- *PostalOne!* System Release 53.2.0.0 *
- Package Platform Release 2.8.0.0
- Program Registration Release 22.4.0.0

During the cited seven-hour implementation and validation window (**5:00 AM CT – 12:00 PM CT**), **impacted systems will remain available**. While unanticipated, if connectivity issues are experienced, users should log-in again.

The **December 12, 2021** Pre-Release Notes (*Change 2.0*) document is attached and also available via PostalPro @ [https://postalpro.usps.com/december-12-2021-\[RollbackofTime-LimitedPriceChange2021\]-release-notes](https://postalpro.usps.com/december-12-2021-[RollbackofTime-LimitedPriceChange2021]-release-notes). As reflected in the *Document History*, the edit reflected in **Change 2.0** includes removal of the DRAFT watermark in accordance with established protocol.

* **REMINDER**: *PostalOne!* System Release 53.2.0.0 **DOES NOT** require a new Mail.dat client. Users should continue to use Mail.dat client **53.0.0.0_PROD**, which was required with the August 15, 2021 *PostalOne!* System release. The Mail.dat client can be downloaded from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).
