[REMINDEES: APRIL-PRICE-CHANGE-2022] Commercial Systems' Activity – Sunday, April 03, 2022

As previously advised [in support of **April-Price-Change-2022**, effective **April 03, 2022**], tomorrow -- **Sunday, April 03, 2022** [from **6:00 AM CT – 11:00 AM CT**], the United States Postal Service will implement software updates for the following Commercial System:

- *PostalOne!* System Release 54.1.1.0 *

NOTES: As referenced in release documentation, other Commercial Systems with Pricing dependencies have also be updated accordingly. And, other updates will be implemented to resolve known issues impacting the Electronic Verification System (eVS) and the Mailer Scorecard landing page.

During the cited implementation and validation window (6:00 AM CT – 11:00 AM CT), **system access WILL NOT be impacted**. However, although unanticipated -- if a connectivity issue is experienced, users are encouraged to log-in again. Immediately after this system activity concludes, notification will be provided.

*There is no new Mail.dat client required for tomorrow's (Sunday, **April 03, 2022**) *PostalOne!* System Release 54.1.1.0. However, as a **REMINDER - PostalOne! System Release 54.1.0.0 on March 20, 2022 included a new REQUIRED Mail.dat client**. Users should download Mail.dat client **54.1.0.0_PROD** from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).
