## INTERNATIONAL SERVICE SUSPENSION NOTICE NEW ZEALAND EFFECTIVE – MAY 13, 2022

Effective Friday, **May 13, 2022**, we will be **suspending acceptance** for the following services to New Zealand due to lack of transportation:

- First-Class Package International Service (FCPIS)
- Commercial ePacket (CeP)
- International Priority Airmail (IPA) Packets
- International Surface Air Lift (ISAL) Packets

This is in addition to the following services to New Zealand's previously suspended on October 1, 2021, and April 1, 2022:

- Airmail M-bags – previously suspended 10/1/21
- International Priority Airmail (IPA) M-bags – previously suspended 10/1/21
- International Surface Air Lift (ISAL) M-bags – previously suspended 10/1/21
- Priority Mail International (PMI) – previously suspended 4/1/22

Also, effective **May 13, 2022**, we will be **suspending acceptance** for the following services destined to China:

- First-Class Package International Service (FCPIS)
- International Priority Airmail (IPA) Packets
- International Surface Air Lift (ISAL) Packets

This is in addition to the following service to China previously suspended on April 29, 2022:

- Priority Mail International (PMI)
