JULY-PRICE CHANGE-2022 – July 10, 2022

As previously advised, on Sunday (*July 10*, 2022) from 5:00 AM CT – 7:00 AM CT, the United States Postal Service will finalize implementation of software updates in support of *July-Price Change-2022* which is effective on that date. Implementation and outage timeframes for all impacted Commercial Systems are below:
