Since the official launch of the PCCAC Health Check Survey in Quarter #4 2022, our team of Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) have examined the responses and identified areas where the PCCs who took the surveys may have needs. An individual "prescription" plan has been written and delivered to each participating PCC with steps they can take to get healthy again.
