Elimination of Priority Mail Express (PME) Label 11-B

PME Label 11B

Effective July 9, 2023, the USPS will eliminate the Priority Mail Express Label 11-B.

Customers who wish to ship Priority Mail Express items, should choose one of the available payment/shipping methods listed below to create PME shipping labels.

Alternative methods may include:

- Local Post Office
- Self-Service Kiosks (SSKs) (where available)
- Click-N-Ship®
- USPS Ship
- Electronic Verification System (eVS®)
- ePostage®
- PC Postage®
- Metered Postage

Note: USPS will continue to accept PME shipments with label 11-B until September 29, 2023. However, the label will no longer be available for order on USPS.com
