## 1.0 Introduction

On Sunday, January 21, 2024, the United States Postal Service implemented the following software change:

- *PostalOne!* System Release 59.0.1.0

These Release Notes provide the contents of the release and affected subsystems. Price changes impacting USPS products and services are effective January 21, 2024.

The section titled **Corrections to Known Issues** is derived from External Trouble Reports (ETRs) and Engineering Change Requests (ECRs) for inclusion in this release.

This document is prepared based on the knowledge available at the time of its publication; any element of its contents is subject to change prior to the release.

Updated postage statements, effective January 21, 2024, are available on Postal Explorer (<http://pe.usps.com>).

## 2.0 Mail.dat Client Support

Please note the following regarding the Mail.dat client download.

There is no new Mail.dat client with this release. Users should continue to use Mail.dat client 59.0.0.0\_PROD. The current Mail.dat client may be downloaded from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).

## 3.0 *PostalOne!* System – Enhancements, Updates, and New Functionality

### 3.1 Price Change

The *PostalOne!* System was updated to support new pricing structures and rates for domestic and international mailings, effective January 21, 2024. To accommodate the pricing and structural changes the Postal Service updated domestic and international postage statements, permit fees, Business Reply Mail (BRM), and Merchandise Return Service (MRS) to reflect the prices on the January 2024 Notice 123, effective January 21, 2024.

## 4.0 *PostalOne!* System – Corrections to Known Issues

### 4.1 *PostalOne!* System Interface with Enterprise Microservice & API Systems (EMAS)

*PostalOne!* System has been updated to include Enterprise Microservice & API Systems (EMAS) in its list of authorized applications. Previously, EMAS was not enabled to use the *PostalOne!* System Nonprofit Application Programming Interface (API) that checks the nonprofit status associated with a given CRID. *PostalOne!* System credentials were provided to EMAS to enable users to check the nonprofit status associated with a given CRID. ### 4.2 Mail.dat and Mail.XML

Mail.dat and Mail.XML have been updated to implement error handling for floating promotion errors. Previously, Mail.dat and Mail.XML did not handle the error related to the incentive denial reason, which prevented a notification from being displayed to the eDoc submitter. Going forward, a message will be shown to the eDoc submitter stating:

- Mail.dat Warning Code 7291 – “The .ccr Characteristic provided was {1}. The floating eligibility check was not met for this promotion. The discount will not be applied.”
- Mail.XML Warning Code 9829 – “The MailCharacteristic provided was {1}. The floating eligibility check was not met for this promotion. The discount will not be applied.” [REQ 24258](#), [ETR 15897](#)
