UPDATE – USPS Ship (PCC) – [INCIDENT # 8855005] Data delay, impacting data provisioning in USPS Ship IV-MTR Data Feeds

The United States Postal Service has identified an issue delaying data in USPS Ship which began on July 16, 2024. The IT team is currently working to resolve the issue. The backlogged data is anticipated to be current by close of business *July 22, 2024*. However, following standard protocol - data processing will be monitored; and updated status assessments provided.
