Boise ID Regional Processing and Distribution Center Goes Live October 1, 2024

As part of the Postal Service's 10-year Delivering for America plan to invest in the postal network in Idaho and across the nation, the Boise ID Regional Processing and Distribution Center (RPDC) (Locale Key Z12429, NASS Code 836) will begin its new operational on October 1, 2024.

Renovating these existing facilities will help the Postal Service bolster effectiveness, strengthen customer service, eliminate long term maintenance costs, and prepare us for the next 30 years of operations.

The operation will remain located at: 2201 S Cole Rd, Boise ID, 83708-9997. As a RPDC, Boise ID RPDC will process letters, flats, and parcel volumes for ZIP Code area: 832-834, 836-837, and 979.

Boise ID RPDC will serve also as a co-located Local Processing Center (LPC) finalizing letters, flats and parcels for ZIP Code areas 833, 836-837, and 979. The Boise ID RPDC will also serve the Pocatello ID LPC located at 1750 Flandro Dr, Pocatello ID, 83201-1970 that will finalize letters, flats and parcels for ZIP Code areas 832 and 834.

Effective October 1, 2024, the Boise ID RPDC will begin processing all NDC destination letter, flat, and parcel volumes for Boise ID 832-834, 836-837, and 979.

Effective with the October 1st Label List updates, Destination Entry drop shipments of letters, flats, and parcels to 832-834, 836-837, and 979 for NDC discount, will be at the Boise ID RPDC.

SCF Destination Entry discounts for letters, flats, and parcel volumes will be available at the following facilities for the 3 Digit zones listed below:

Boise ID LPC (NASS: 836LP) – 833, 836-837, and 979 (letters, flats, & parcels) 832 and 834 (flats and parcels only)

Pocatello ID LPC (NASS: 832) - 832 and 834 (letters only)

The grace period will be honored for letters, flats, and parcel volume for 3-Digit ZIP Codes 832-834, 836-837, and 979 entered at Salt Lake City ASF and Denver NDC during the month of October.
