2. After implementation activities conclude, users should download Mail.dat client **64.0.0.0\_PROD** from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).
3. The effective date for the Price Change release is July 12, 2026.
