## Hurricane Irma Update

The Northeast Area and Caribbean District are suspending **all** operations in Puerto Rico mainland at 0100 September 6, 2017. There will be no retail and delivery operations in the Caribbean District (SCFs 006-009) on Wednesday September 6, 2017 until further notice. All drop ships and FAST appointments are suspended as well.

With impacts expected for the Caribbean Islands, Priority Mail Express and shipment of lives to Puerto Rico and Virgin Islands has been suspended until further notice.
