The San Juan P&DC and Catano DMDU Annex are closed and not accepting FAST appointments.

There will be no retail services, package or mail pick up at any location in 006-009.

USPS is not accepting Priority Mail Express service or shipment of live animals for the following ZIP Codes: 006, 007, 008 and 009.

There will be no Priority Mail Express service or shipment of live animals in Puerto Rico due to the hurricane.

There will be no retail services, package or mail pickup at any location on St. John today.
