

- Not accepting drop shipments





Change of Address Management



Implemented disaster response option on Internet Change-of-Address website to allow customers to enter COAs without a credit card if old address from an impacted area.

Activated Emergency Changeof-Address function that allows USPS personnel to submit COAs for persons domiciled in shelters.

CONTAMINATION MANAGEMENT



Contaminated MTE Management

- Submerged sacks, trays, sleeves, tubs cannot be returned to USPS
- Contaminated MTE must be inventoried by the mailer and submitted to the local BSN for assistance
- USPS will assess mailer on-hand inventory from MTEOR for estimate of amount of MTE that was on-hand when Harvey struck

Harvey Support

- PME and LIVES embargo messaging to retail employees via Retail Digest, Retail Standup Talks, and RSS memo messaging
- 120 mPOS devices from Areas excluding Southern to be loaned to Houston offices during recovery
- No fee PO Boxes for displaced residents have been set up
- Areas to provide Rotary PO Boxes for affected Houston offices
