## Address Quality Census Measurement and Assessment Process Federal Register Notice

The Address Quality Census Measurement and Assessment Process Federal Register Notice was published today, October 24, 2017. The Postal Service is revising Mailing Standards of the United States Postal Service, Domestic Mail Manual to include a new method of Move Update verification and assessment procedure for evaluating address quality, the ``Address Quality Census Measurement and Assessment Process." This new procedure is applicable to mailers who enter eligible letter- and flat-size pieces of First-Class Mail® and USPS Marketing Mail<sup>TM</sup> that meet the requirements for Basic or Full- Service mailings. In addition, the Postal Service is extending no-fee Address Correction Service (ACS<sup>TM</sup>) to mailers who enter qualifying mailpieces.
